b. Course Objectives

This course, IELTS4, aims to

- > further develop your critical thinking and academic language skills required for IELTS
- enable you to deal with exam question types and enhance your key grammar and vocabulary which are known to be useful to candidates doing the test
- > equip you with test-taking strategies to maximize your scores in all parts of the test
- > enable you to reach an overall IELTS band **6.5**.

c. Course Assessment

- You are required to do the Final Test at the end of the course. The test consists of four components: Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking. The formats of the test components are identical to the real IELTS Test.
- Test duration: Listening: ~30 minutes; Reading: 60 minutes; Writing: 60 minutes; Speaking: 8-10 minutes
- Test scores: The tests are marked in accordance with the IELTS Marking Schemes and Criteria for the four parts.

d. Course Requirements

In order to successfully complete the course and to receive a certificate of course completion, you must:

- ➤ Attend at least 70% of class sessions in class.
- Achieve a passing grade on the final test.

- Certificates of Attendance' will be issued on request to any student providing that he/she attends class regularly.
